Psalm 139 is a powerful reminder of God's deep care and intimate knowledge of each of us.

When Matilda was born 2.5 months early, weighing only 1 kg, she was fragile, but this Psalm shows us that even in moments of weakness or vulnerability, we are never insignificant.

The Lord knows us intimately, from the moment we are conceived:

"For You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother's womb" (Psalm 139:13 NIV).

Even before she was born, God had already written the days of Matilda's life. Her small and fragile body was not a sign of insignificance, but of the Creator's profound attention to every detail. Just as Matilda was fearfully and wonderfully made (Psalm 139:14), we too are crafted with purpose, no matter our size, strength, or circumstances. God does not make mistakes.
