BYO drinks, nibbles, afternoon tea.


A gold coin donation on arrival would be appreciated, and tea/coffee is available.

Operation Christmas Child (OCC)

We ordered 100 OCC boxes assuming this would be ample. They were all taken over the weekend so we have ordered another 25 boxes which will be available on Sunday after both services and from the church office as of next week. One can imagine the joy these will bring to children and families this Christmas.



The \$1 cost of purchasing each box has been covered by a

Fellowship Group but you will need to pay the \$12.50 to cover the cost of transportation and materials for the follow up discipleship program. This can be paid online (as outlined in the brochure) or placed in an envelope and included in the box.

To enable the boxes to be delivered to a central point to be transported to the Philippines they need to be returned by Sunday 29th September. Boxes can be brought on any Sunday and left on the table advertising the OCC or delivered to the church office. They will be stored securely until 25th September.
