This was a significant Synod- bringing an end to the long-lasting debate in relation to woman's ordination to the office of ministry.

- LCANZ to join Lutheran World Federation not passed
- LCA to establish a training and accreditation authority -passed
- Minimum tenure of service as a pastor before promotion to role of Bishop not passed
- ALWS constitution change passed.
