DISCUSS

When Jesus appeared to his disciples he said "peace be with you". What did that mean? How does the resurrection make a difference in your life?



ACTION RESPONSE

It connects directly to Jesus greeting his disciples in the resurrection. Share a sign of peace with each other by saying, "The peace of the Lord Jesus be with you."
