
## Growing Faith at Home

## AGM Round Up

The Annual General Meeting for Good Shepherd Para Vista was held on Sunday the 19<sup>th</sup> of May, in conjunction with a call meeting.

The following items were discussed during the meeting:

- During the call meeting, the congregation voted overwhelmingly to Call Pastor Nathan Hedt. Nathan will be meeting with Church leadership in the coming weeks. Please continue to pray for Pastor Nathan, as he discerns his current call, in conjunction with the call to GSPV.
- District synod representative Peter Nitschke reported on the discussion that took place at the district synod on the 4<sup>th</sup> of May. There were many topics covered at Synod including the current changes to ALC, the sale of the North Adelaide properties, as well as an update on the "Way Forward" framework that was recently presented.
- The Ministry team reported on the revitalisation of the pastoral care team, with new appointments for leadership in this area, as well as the continued success on ministries such as "Meet and Eat" and "KAPS"
- A motion was put to the congregation asking for support for the development of a new youth worker intern position. After discussion and feedback from the floor, the motion was withdrawn, and an informal straw poll was held. The congregation showed support for a role to be developed in this area. The GSPV leadership teams will investigate and present to the congregation a formal framework at a later date.
- The school presented a proposal to relocate the large waste bins from the carpark exit to the western side of the church so that a new Koala Crossing can be built, providing a safe way for student to access the ELC. Questions were collected from the floor and these answers will be presented at a later date.

## May Food Collection

Last year 690 people sought Emergency Relief through Lutheran Care. 44% of these were first time requests, which indicates more and more people are struggling in these hard times. Lutheran Care conducted 2062 interviews with people seeking assistance. This was an average of 40 per week.

The majority were seeking assistance with food so they could feed their families and ensure the children had school lunches. They were also seeking assistance with clothing, shoes, toiletries, and travel costs.

These people had a variety of issues including ill-health, homelessness, sleeping rough or escaping family violence.

May was another great month for our food collection in support of Lutheran Care. Our collections help support those people mentioned above. Some people pre-empted the winter appeal by donating quilts and blankets. Goods donated are distributed throughout the Northern, Northeast and Eastern suburbs of Adelaide. A big thank you to everyone.


Each day there are exciting activities to help reinforce the message we received from our pastor, and a praise party pumps us up for the day through some bang'n tunes!

This fundraiser will support Lutheran Care's 2024 Winter Appeal and help us continue our work with people experiencing crisis and homelessness in our communities.


