WHITE is the colour of purity, light and completeness. It is used at Christmas to celebrate Jesus' purity and glory as the Son of God and the joy we find in him.

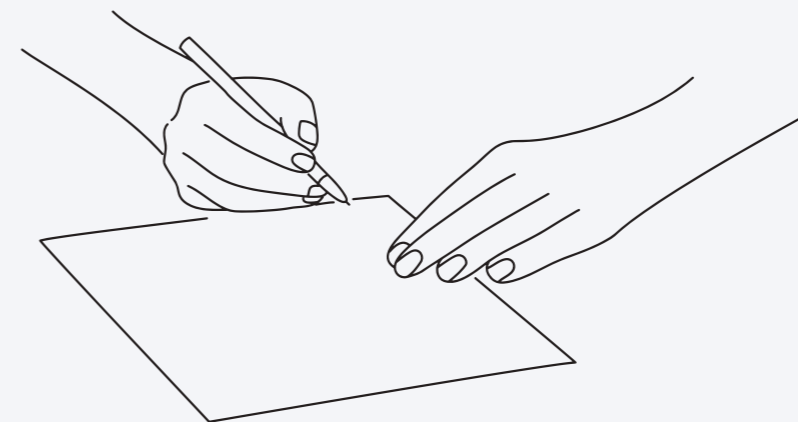
Creative Response
