TRINITY TRIANGLE CRAFT

This is an easy Trinity craft for preschool children. It is a simple illustration of how three things come together to make one. We used red, the colour of fire, to symbolise the Holy Spirit, as he came with tongues of fire. Yellow, the colour of light, represents Jesus, the light of the world. Finally, blue symbolises our Heavenly Father.

You will need:

- Coloured pop sticks (blue, yellow and red)
- Black markers
- Glue
- A piece of wool or string

What to do:

1. Give each child three pop sticks.
2. Write: Father, Son, Holy Spirit, one on each pop stick with a marker.
3. Glue each pop stick together, one at a time into a triangle shape.
4. Tie a piece of string around it so it can be hung up.
